- () 1. A-65 makes a block above the waist and from the front of B-78. He then momentarily loses contact, pursues B-78 and then blocks him in the back. RULING: Illegal block in the back (2-5-2)
- () 2. Both fouls may be enforced when the opponent of the scoring team commits a foul on both a TD scoring play and the subsequent try. (2-16-2e)
- () 3. The head coach may designate another coach for the purpose of requesting time-outs. (3-5-2a)
- () 4. A defensive player may push/pull the offensive blocker out of the way in an actual attempt by him to get at the runner or a loose ball. The block may be in the back above or below the waist.(2-3-5)(9-3-5)
- () 5. B-74 piles on to runner A-32 out of bounds after time has run out in the 3rd period. The referee will administer the penalty and extend the period by one untimed down which is free of any fouls. (3-3-5)
- () 6. K's kick-off is first touched by K-42 on the K 48 yard line. It is then recovered by R-67 on the R 47 yard line. R may put the ball in play at the K 48 yard line. (6-1-6)
- () 7. Place kick holder K-15 rises from his position with his knee on the ground and takes a step to receive the high snap. He then returns to his original position with knee on the ground and holds the ball for the kicker, or rises again with his knee off the ground to pass to a teammate. RULING: Legal play (4-2-2a2)
- () 8. Both a loose ball and a ball in player possession become dead if they touch another player standing on the sideline (2-29)
- () 9. B-76, nose tackle, charges directly into snapper A-55 immediately after his snap to punter A-45. RULING: Personal foul by B-76. Penalize B 15 yards and an automatic first down for A (2-38-2)
- () 10. Roughing the passer is committed against a player who throws a legal forward pass. (2-32-11)
- () 11. An inadvertent whistle is blown while R-18's fumble is loose during his return of K's punt. R may take the ball at the spot of the fumble or elect to have the down replayed. (4-3-2b)
- () 12. Substitute A-34 enters the game on 2nd down. B-79 encroaches on the ensuing play. A-34 may be substituted for before another play is run. (3-7-4)
- () 13. An illegal kick is treated as a fumble. (2-24-9)
- () 14. B-22 intercepts A-11's pass in the air over his one yard line. He returns to the ground in his end zone inbounds and is downed. RULING: B will have the ball 1st and ten on the one yard line. (2-4-1)(2-32-1)
- () 15. B-22 leaps in the air and intercepts A's pass on his two yard line. He comes down inbounds at the one yard line and his momentum carries him back into his end zone where he is downed. B will next snap from their one yard line. (2-4-1)(8-5-2)

- () 16. 2nd down and goal from B's nine yard line. A-81 leaps into the air and has A-12's pass in his grasp when he is hit by B-23. He comes to the ground at the B two yard line and is driven out of bounds at the B four yard line. His forward progress was stopped at the two. RULING: A's ball at the two and the clock will continue to run. (2-4-1)
- () 17. A-81 leaps in the air and has A-12's pass caught over B's goal line when he is hit by B-23 and is driven back into the field of play, landing at the B one yard line. RULING: Touchdown. (2-15-2)
- () 18. An offensive player, in an upright stance, to be legally in the backfield, must not break the plane of the waist line of his nearest teammate, who is on the line, with any part of his body. (2-30-3)
- () 19. A player may participate with a cast or other hard substance, properly padded, on his wrist, hand, forearm or elbow only if it has been directed in writing by a licensed medical physician to protect an injury. (1-5-3c)
- () 20. R-22 attempts to catch K's scrimmage kick but muffs it into his end zone where K-83 recovers.
RULING: Touchdown for K. (2-13-3,4)(8-5-3a)
- () 21. Phones and/or headsets may be used by coaches, other non-players, and players; however, players in the game may only use them during authorized sideline conferences. (1-6-2)
- () 22. Fighting includes striking or engaging an opponent in a combative manner unrelated to football, and attempting to strike an opponent, whether or not there is contact (2-11)
- () 23. A substitute that enters the field during a down is guilty of illegal participation whether or not he contacts an opponent or influences the play.
- () 24. When the helmet comes completely off a player who is in possession of the ball the ball will become dead if an opponent is within 2 yards. (4-2-2k)
- () 25. During each overtime period each team is permitted only one time out. (3-5-1)
