7. K14's free kick is airborne but completely over out-of-bounds ground when it is touched first by R22, who is straddling the sideline at the R-37. As a result: (2-29-3, 6.1.9C)
 - a. The ball remains live.
 - b. It will be team R's ball at team R's 37 yardline.
 - c. Team K is flagged for kicking the ball out of bounds.
8. K, 4/3, R-30. From scrimmage-kick formation K13 drop kicks the ball. The ball goes off the side of K13's foot and out of bounds at R-10 yardline. (2-24-6,6-2-7)

 - A, 2/1, B-47

12. A, 1/10, A-20. A42 advances to the A-30 when he is hit and fumbles. While the ball is in flight, B36 bats the ball toward his own goalline. B25 catches the ball at the A-34 and is tackled immediately. (2-2, 9-7-2)
- A, 1/10, A-45 after penalty for illegal batting.
 - A, 1/10, A-30.
 - B, 1/10, A-34
13. A, 3/6, B-8. A24 is running near the sideline. At the B-2, he dives for the goalline, but is hit by B42. The ball breaks the plane of the goalline extended but airborne A24 lands out of bounds. (2-26-3, 2.26.3b)
- Touchdown.
 - A, 1/G, B-2.
 - A, 1/G, at the yardline where foremost point of the ball crossed the sideline.
14. A, 2/8, B-38. After Team A has been set for 1 second, linemen A66, A72 and A77 move from a 2-point to a 3-point stance at the same time A22 goes in motion. The ball is snapped while the players are still moving. (2-39, 2.39)
- Live ball foul. A, 2/13, B-43. Illegal shift.
 - Live ball foul. A, 2/13, B-43. Illegal motion.
 - Dead ball foul.
15. K, 4/6, K-28. K is in a scrimmage kick formation. Immediately after the snap, R78 contacts the snapper, K28. Punter K18 takes the snap, fakes a kick and runs to the K-34. (2-32-14, 9-4-6)
- Roughing the snapper, K, 1/10, K-43.
 - Roughing the snapper, K, 1/10, K-49.
 - No foul because K did not kick.
16. A, 2/9, A-40. A10 drops back to pass at the A-32. As his arm comes forward, he is hit by B77 and is turned around so that the ball falls to the ground at the A-30. B77 recovers the ball at the A-29. (2-31-2 NOTE)
- Fumble, B, 1/10, A-29.
 - Backward pass, B, 1/10, A-29.
 - Incomplete pass, A, 3/9, A-40
17. A, 2/5, A-40. A51 and B60 are on the line in the free blocking zone. After the snap, A51 blocks B60 from behind and below the waist and A32 runs the ball to the A-48. (2-5-1)
- Legal block. A, 1/10, A-48.
 - Illegal block in the back. A, 2/15, A-30.
 - Clipping, A, 2/20, A-20.

18. K, Kickoff, K-40. K6 runs forward to kick the ball high into the air for a short onside kick. As he is running forward but before kicking the ball, K42 has his foot down on the K-41. The kick goes to the K-48 where it is caught by R88. (2-8)
- Live ball foul. K Rekick, K-35.
 - Live ball foul. R, 1/10, K-48.
 - Dead ball foul. K, Rekick, K-35
 - a and b
19. Targeting can only be called if the player contacted is defenseless. (2-20-2)

24. A, 1/10, B-33. Immediately after the snap, snapper A50 dives to his left and contacts defensive tackle, B65 at the knees at the B-34. A42 runs to the B-26 where he is tackled. (2-17-2, 2-3-8)

 - Illegal block below the waist. A, 1/24, B-49
 - Chop block. A, 1/24, B-49
 - Chop block, A, 1/18, B-41
