

CFOA RULES 1, 3, 4 TEST - 2017

1. All Officials are traveling separately to the game site. The Referee must wait until the Umpire arrives to go talk with the coaches. (1-5-1a(2) NOTE, 1-5-4)
 - a. True
 - b. False
2. A, 4/9, A-44. Substitute B33 realizing that his team has only 10 players on the field, enters the field at the B-46 during the down, but the play goes to the other side of the field where A22 is downed at the B-49. (3-7-6)
 - a. Dead ball foul. A, 2/4, B-49
 - b. Live ball foul. A, 1/10, B-44
 - c. Live ball foul. A, 2/4, B-49
3. A, 4/8, B-42. With the game clock running, A14 is calling signals when guard, A62 false starts. There are 22 seconds remaining on the game clock in the second period. (3-4-7 New)
 - a. A, 4/13, B-47, clock starts on the snap
 - b. A, 4/13, B-47, clock starts on the Ready
 - c. A, 4/13, B-47, B has a choice to start the game clock on the ready or the snap
4. A, 3/6, A-41. Runner A32 is hit at the A-44. Which of the following causes the ball to become dead? (4-2-2i)
 1. A32's helmet comes off
 2. A32's mouthpiece comes out
 3. A32's prosthetic hand comes off
 4. A32 loses his shoe
 - a. All
 - b. 1 & 2
 - c. 1 & 3
 - d. 1 & 4
5. The home Team A Coach verifies that all his players are legally equipped. The team A QB is wearing play cards in a device attached to his belt. (1-5-3-c-8)
 - a. Legal
 - b. 5 yard penalty for illegal equipment
 - c. 15 yard penalty for illegal equipment
 - d. 15 yard penalty for unsportsmanlike conduct on head coach
6. K, 4/5, R-26. K6 attempts a field goal. R42 partially blocks the kick behind the line. K24 recovers the kick at the R-19 and advances to the R-15. (4-2-2f, 6-2-4)
 - a. K, 1/10, R-15
 - b. R, 1/10, R-26
 - c. R, 1/10, R-19
7. A, 2/8, A-32. A15 runs off tackle. B75 tackles A15 at the A-34 with a hard hit that causes A15's helmet to pop off and A15 fumbles. B51 recovers the fumble at the A-35. (4-2-2k, 4.2.2.J)
 - a. B, 1/10, A-35, A15 must leave the field for one play
 - b. A, 3/5, A-35, A15 must leave the field for one play
 - c. A, 1/10, A-49 after a 15 yard penalty, A15 does not have to leave the field because of the penalty
 - d. A, 3/6, A-34, A15 must leave the field for one play
 - e. None of the above

8. K, 4/13, K-36. The clock is stopped after an incomplete pass. K6 kicks the ball from the K-26. R22 signals for a fair catch at the R40 but muffs the ball. An official blows an inadvertent whistle while the ball is loose. When the down is replayed: (3-4-2c)
- The clock shall start on the ready because of the inadvertent whistle
 - The clock shall start on the ready because of the fair catch signal
 - The clock shall start on the snap because it is after a legal kick
9. After play #7 above, The B Coach requests a coach-referee conference regarding misapplication of a rule. After the conference, there is no change to the ruling and Team B had no time-outs remaining. (3-5-11, 3-6-2c)
- Team B is penalized for unsportsmanlike conduct
 - Team B is penalized for delay of game
 - There is no penalty because the ruling is not changed
10. A, 3/6, B-8. A42 catches a legal forward pass in the end zone for an apparent touchdown as time for the first period expires. B18 is flagged for holding A42 at the line of scrimmage. A chooses to have the penalty enforced on the kickoff. (3-5-11, 3-6-2c)
- The try is attempted in the second period
 - A must decline the penalty
 - Teams will switch goals and A will kickoff from the 50 after the penalty
 - A must have the penalty enforced on the try
11. K, 4/6, R-22, K14 is the holder with K-6 as the kicker in a field goal formation. K14 receives the snap at the R-30 with his knees on the ground. Without rising, he tosses the ball to K44 running in front of him at the R-26. K44 advances for a touchdown. (4-2-2a Exceptions)
- Touchdown
 - R, 1/10, R-35 after penalty for an illegal pass
 - R, 1/10, R-30
 - K, 4/19, R-35 after 5 yard penalty
12. A, 2/8, A-43. After the first down play, QB A14 has a bloody nose. The Referee stops the clock and sends A14 to his sideline. The Team A coach requests a time-out. During the time-out, the bleeding is stopped and A14 returns to the huddle. (3-5-10c, 3.5.10.A)
- Because A called a time-out, A14 can return
 - Only an outside the 9-yard marks conference can be held
 - A14 must remain in his team box for at least one down
13. A, 2/10, A-20. With the clock running, A62 false starts. After the penalty is enforced, there are 6 seconds on the clock. It is started and the first period ends before the ball is snapped. (3-4-7)
- A, 2/15, A-15. Period is ended
 - A, 2/10, A-20. Extend the period
 - A, 2/15, A-15. Extend the period
 - Reset the clock to 6 seconds and start on the snap
14. A, 1/10, B-40. There are 32 seconds remaining in the first half. After a fair catch, A elects to put the ball in play with a snap. A15 drops back and passes the ball to A87 at the B-30. B24 is called for pass interference and the pass is incomplete. A accepts the penalty. (4-3-7, 4.3.7)
- A, 1/10, B-25. Clock starts on the snap
 - A, Free kick, B-25. A attempts a field goal. Clock starts when kick is touched by R
 - A, Free kick, B-25. A attempts a field goal. Clock starts when the ball is kicked
 - a & b
 - b & c
15. An Officials Timeout occurs after a try, safety or a successful field goal. (3-5-8-a2)
- Either type of authorized conference may be used
 - Only a conference at the sideline in front of the team box can be used
 - Only a conference inside the 9 yard marks between the coach and no more than 11 players

16. K, 4/6, K-28. K is in a scrimmage kick formation. Immediately after the snap, K78 holds R82 at the K-20. Punter K18 kicks the ball. It is caught by R22 at the R-40 and returned to the R-45. R accepts the penalty. (3-4-2b-3, 3.4.2D)
- K, 4/24, K-10, clock starts on the ready
 - K, 4/16, K-22, clock starts on the ready
 - R, 1/10, K-45, clock starts on the snap
17. K, 4/9, K-40. K10 kicks the ball and it comes to rest at the R-23. K46 touches the ball and R25 picks up the ball and runs to the R-47 where he is tackled. (4-2-2f)
- R, 1/10, R-47. Clock starts on the snap
 - R, 1/10, R-47. Clock starts on the ready
 - R, 1/10, R-23. Clock starts on the snap
 - R, 1/10, R-23. Clock starts on the ready
18. K, 4/5, R-26. K12's attempted field goal hits the upright, caroms toward the field and is caught by R22 in team R's end zone. (4-2-2-d-2)
- The ball remains live
 - The ball should be declared dead when the ball hits the upright. R, 1/10, R-20
 - The ball should be declared dead when the ball hits the upright. R, 1/10, R-26
 - Team K scores a safety
19. Team A scores on the final play of regulation time, making the score 26-24 in favor of team B. On the play, B1 grabbed and twisted A2's facemask. (3-3-3d, 8-2-2)
- If accepted, the penalty must be enforced on the try
 - A may have the penalty enforced at the start of overtime if team A ties the score with the try
 - The penalty is declined by rule
20. K, 4/6, R-22. K is out of timeouts and is attempting to kick a 45-yard field goal as the half is expiring. With the clock running, the referee holds the ready to allow the line judge to get to the goalpost. The ball is snapped before the ready.
- A 15-yard penalty for unsportsmanlike conduct
 - A five-yard penalty for delay
 - No foul because the officials held up the game
21. K, 4/10, K-20. K1 is flagged for kick-catching interference, which causes R2 to muff the kick. R3 recovers at the K-45 and time for the first quarter expires during the down. (3-3-3a)
- The period will be extended for an untimed down under any circumstance
 - The period will be extended for an untimed down only if team R chooses to have a yardage penalty enforced or chooses an awarded fair catch at the spot of K1's interference
 - The period cannot be extended for an untimed down under any circumstance
22. A, 2/9, A-30. A19 fumbles at the A-38 yardline. The ball bounces high into the air. B24 leaps, controls the ball while airborne and lands so he is touching the sideline at the A-40 yardline. (4-3-1)
- B, 1/10, A-40
 - A, 3/1, A-38
 - A, 1/10, A-40
23. A, 3/10, A-20. Team A's coach, thinking that it's fourth down, sends punter A7 onto the field. When A7 reaches the huddle and tells A11 to leave the game, he is told it's only third down. A7 requests a timeout and then returns to his team box. (3-7-3, 3.7.3D)
- Legal.
 - Flag A immediately for illegal substitution.
 - A7 must stay in the game for one play.

24. K, 4/6, K-42. K55 punts the ball from the K-35. R22 signals for a fair catch but muffs the ball. K86 recovers the ball at the R-20 and runs to the R-15 before he is tackled. (3-4-3c)

- a. K, 1/10, R-15. Clock starts on the snap
- b. K, 1/10, R-15. Clock starts on the ready
- c. K, 1/10, R-20. Clock starts on the snap
- d. K, 1/10, R-20. Clock starts on the ready

25. K, Kickoff, K-40. R26 muffs the kick at the R-5. The ball rolls into the end zone where K49 recovers it. (4-2-2-d1)

- a. Touchdown for K
- b. R, 1/10, R-5
- c. R, 1/10, R-20
